 - One that is of a personal nature from a friend of the family, teacher/professor.
 - One that is from a community leader, a priest, clergy, scout leader, public official.
- _____ 4. A personal essay that addresses all of the following points:
 - What you have gained or learned through horseback riding?
 - How this knowledge or insight has applied to your daily life?
 - What are your future goals?
 - What would you say to an upcoming young rider, i.e. advice about the worth of riding?
 - What impact would receiving a CHJA Scholarship have upon your educational options and your future goals?
