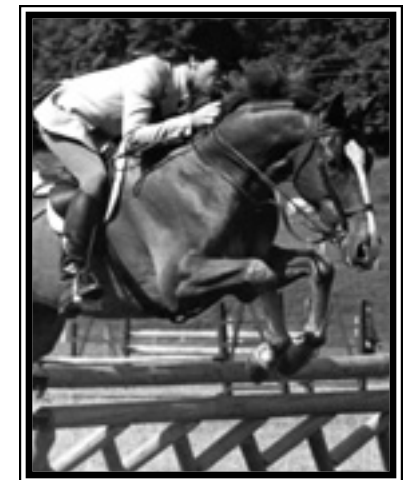
ABOUT THE JUDGES FOR THE 2010 CHJA MEDAL FINALS



Fran Dotoli began her lifelong horse passion while in elementary school, riding and showing hunters in the Northeast. She went on to Stonehill College, where she graduated in 1968 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in sociology. Her commitment to horses influenced her decision to make the horse business a career. In 1970, she started Young Entry Stable in Massachusetts with her husband Joe. During this time, they trained the 1982 the ASPCA Maclay Winner, Peter Wyld. She obtained her United States Equestrian Federation Hunter, Jumper, and Hunter Seat Equitation judges license, which has enabled her to travel the country. Fran and Joe closed their private barn in 1992 and moved to Ox Ridge Hunt Club, where they were responsible for the management and show training duties of approximately 60 horses. In 2004, Fran and Joe retired from Ox Ridge and moved to Vermont. Fran remains active in the horse industry, serving

on the USEF committees for Hunter Seat Equitation and Clinics, Continuing Education and acting as an equine consultant to universities and professional horsemen for their equine acquisitions, training, and marketing needs. Fran and Joe have two daughters, Ann who is a professional horsewoman in Vermont, and Julia, who is an artist in New York City.

John Manning was born into a family of professional horsemen and women, and grew up riding, showing and helping his parents with the equestrian program at C.W. Post College on Long Island. After graduating from Cornell University, John stayed in the horse industry and worked for Dave Kelley in Southern Pines, N.C. and then Mark Jungherr, in Rye, N.Y. He ultimately became the Director of Riding for the Stoneleigh-Burnham School, a position he held for over 22 years before purchasing Biscuit Hill Farm in Shelburne, MA with his wife Beth. Biscuit Hill Farm is a 35 stall facility on 30 acres with one of the largest privately owned indoor rings in the region. John's students have competed successfully in all of the major equitation finals. Biscuit Hill is also the home of the Amherst College Equestrian Team and the Hopkins Academy IEA Equestrian Team. For over 20 years John has been in demand as a well liked and well respected USEF licensed judge in Hunter, Jumper, and Hunter Seat Equitation. He also possesses course designer licenses for both Hunters and Jumpers. He has judged most major A-Rated horse shows around the country including Zone 2 Hunter Finals, CHJA Finals, LA Medal Finals and the Northern California Medal Finals. John and Beth have three daughters, Bailey, Caitlin and Eliza that also ride and help with the business at the farm.

To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability and manners to count. To be scored under the open numerical judging system using two judges. Each competitor will jump one round of approximately ten fences. The twelve horses with the highest scores from the first round will return to jump a second round over a different course. In the event of equality affecting the selection of the top twelve, all those equal will qualify. The scores of the horses in the second round will be added to the first round scores and placed in order of their total score for the two rounds. Horses tied for first place only will jump a third round over a shortened course. Ties for all other places will remain tied. To be shown over a course of approximately ten jumps not to exceed 3' in height with spreads to 3'. Small/medium ponies to jump 2', and large ponies to jump 2'6" with spreads to 2'6". Horses to jump first in the first round.
