

ABOUT THE JUDGES FOR THE 2011 CHJA MEDAL FINALS



Todd Karn, a horse lover as long as he can remember, started riding Western at eight years old, but switched to English by the time he was ten. Through his junior years he rode with Carol Molony and Kip Rosenthal, "two people that have become life long friends." He never owned his own horse as a junior, and worked in the family's store to afford entry fees. But in 1976 he borrowed a retired horse from a friend, and under Kip's very patient eye, qualified and rode in the Medal and Maclay Finals.

Todd rode while at Bennett College in Millbrook NY, and soon after launched his professional career, starting at the Ox Ridge Hunt Club. He has ridden many talented horses, including "Chital," a hunter purchased from Mr. & Mrs. William Steinkraus that excelled in the zone and placed at the National Horse Show in Regular Working Hunters. There was also "The Wizard," the 1994 Regular Conformation Hunter Champion at Devon, owned by the late Anne E. Dyson, a friend and wonderful client.

Todd received his judge's card at the age of 25 and has judged many top shows, among them The Hampton Classic, Capital Challenge, Middleburg National, and the New England Medal Finals. Todd resides in Fayetteville, NY, near Syracuse, and continues to show, teach and bring along young prospects.

Chrystine Jones Tauber of Wellington, Florida, is an accomplished equestrian with an extensive equine business and industry background. The former Executive Director of the American Horse Shows Association, is now Secretary of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF), and is a member of the Executive Committee as well as the Board of Directors. She is currently Vice President of the U.S. Hunter Jumper Association (USHJA), and is a member of the Emerging Athletes and the Trainer's Certification Committees. She also serves on the USEF's Licensed Officials Committee. Tauber was appointed to the Kentucky Governor's Advisory Commission for the 2010 World Equestrian Games, and is a Board member of the Show Jumping Hall of Fame.

Chrystine has judged most major horse shows in the United States and Canada, as well as the Washington International Finals, the USEF Medal and USEF Talent Search Finals, and ASPCA Maclay



National Championships numerous times. She earned her rating as an International Course Designer and Judge from the Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) in 1977 and has worked in North America, Bermuda, Australia and Europe. In 1983, she served as the Technical Delegate for the FEI at the World Cup Finals in Vienna.
