ABOUT THE JUDGES FOR THE 2023 CHJA MEDAL FINALS



Todd Karn, a horse lover as long as he can remember, started riding Western at eight years old, but switched to English by the time he was ten. Through his junior years he rode with Carol Molony and Kip Rosenthal, "two people that have become lifelong friends." He never owned his own horse as a junior, and worked in the family's store to afford entry fees. But in 1976 he borrowed a retired horse from a friend, and under Kip's very patient eye, qualified and rode in the Medal and Maclay Finals. Todd rode while at Bennett College in Millbrook NY, and soon after launched his professional career, starting at the Ox Ridge Hunt Club. Todd received his judge's card at the age of 25 and has judged many top shows, among them the Hampton Classic, Capital Challenge, Middleburg National, and the New England Medal Finals. Todd resides in Fayetteville, NY, near Syracuse, and continues to show, teach and bring along young prospects.



Mark Frohm started in the horse business with his mom and dad at High View Farm in Pittsford, NY in 1978. He rode and trained riders to many Championships as well as ten Zone 2 Champions and Reserve Champions at the Junior Hunter Finals. He also had many Junior Equitation riders qualify for the Medal and Maclay Regionals and Finals. In much demand as a judge, Mark has held his judge's card for over twenty-five years and has judged throughout the United States and Canada.




"Bob is always the first to come over to the CHJA Tent during Finals and offer to help, no matter what the job, even though he will be showing himself!"
